

### Quilt Preparation Checklist

#### **☼** Piecing

- Press seams as you piece; ensure they're secure.
- Trim all thread tails (front & back)—dark threads can shadow under lighter fabrics.
- Remove all pins.
- Puckers and fullness cannot be quilted out.
- Mark the top of directional tops/backings with a safety pin or tag.
- Tops without borders should be staystitched on the outside edges.
- Press the top from the front side, taking care not to stretch or distort.
- Note: Additional prep (pressing, thread trimming, repairs) may incur a fee.





#### **Borders**

- Ensure your quilt is as square as possible.
   For best results, measure the quilt's center in three places before cutting border pieces.
  - Length: Average three vertical measurements. Cut two borders to that length, pin to sides, ease in, sew, and press.
  - Width: Average three horizontal measurements. Repeat the process for top and bottom borders.
- Attach borders properly—avoid excess fabric that causes waviness because waviness cannot be quilted out.
- Backstitch outer seams to keep them from opening on the frame.

#### **Backing**

- Backing must be 10" larger than your quilt top (e.g., 60" x 60" top needs 70" x 70" backing). This extra fabric allows it to be secured to the longarm frame.
- If piecing, use a ½" seam and press seams open. Remove selvages.
- Square your backing to prevent puckering.
- Press the entire backing thoroughly.
- DO NOT use sheets—high thread count makes them unsuitable for quilting.
- Need fabric? We carry a wide selection of 108" wide backing!
- Call the longarm room for guidance if planning to use fleece or other backing fabric.

#### **Batting**

- 70% cotton/30% poly included as part of the Panto/Edge-to-Edge charge, OR
- Choose alternative batting options for an additional charge: 80/20% cotton/poly or wool blend, bamboo blend, 100% cotton, flame retardant, or 100% poly (white or black)

#### **Threads**

• We offer a wide range of thread colors, including variegated options.
